Annual Budget

One of the primary responsibilities of the School Board is to secure funds to carry out a program of adequate education as defined by RSA 193-E:2.

The adopted annual school budget is the financial outline of the district's educational program; it is the legal basis for the establishment of tax rates. The annual school budget process is an important function of school district operations. It serves as a means to improve communications within the school organization and with the residents of the community.

The Superintendent shall be responsible for preparing and presenting to the Board a proposed school budget. The Board expects the Superintendent to work closely with the principal and other administrators in their respective areas in studying the needs of the schools and in compiling a budget to meet those needs. The principal is expected to confer with appropriate staff in getting budgetary requests and information on requirements.

The calendar for annual budget will comply with all legal requirements. The budget calendar will be approved by the School Board.
