

Age of Enrollment and Kindergarten Readiness

A student may enter kindergarten if his/her chronological age will be five before September 30 of the year of entering school.

All students, upon registering for admission to Kindergarten will be screened for developmental readiness. If they are not ready for full-day kindergarten, parents can opt to wait a year or put them in half-day kindergarten. CVS will support the appropriate educational programming for every student in collaboration with parents.

A student may enter grade 1 if his/her chronological age will be six before September 30 of the year of entering school.

A birth certificate must be presented upon registration as proof of the date of birth.

In-coming transfer students in grades K-4, inclusive, will be initially placed in accordance with the data forwarded by the sending District. Such placement is tentative and subject to reassignment by the Superintendent of Schools or his/her designee.
