ADMISSION OF HOMELESS STUDENTS

The Croydon School District will provide homeless students district services for which they are eligible.

Homeless students are defined in RSA 193:12.

The Superintendent shall designate an appropriate staff person to be the district's liaison for homeless students and their families.

To the extent feasible, homeless students will continue to be enrolled in their school of origin while they remain homeless or until the end of the academic year in which they obtain permanent housing.

Homeless students are entitled to transportation to their school of origin or the school where they are to be enrolled in accordance with the law.
